**Colin Jacks** has published a number of books about his experiences on BR when based at Tyseley (Birmingham), when he frequently worked over the former Honeybourne Line (now GWSR). He then went on to be a long-serving driver on the formative GWSR, retiring after driving the Royal Train carrying HRH The Princess Royal to open Cheltenham Racecourse station in 2003.

**Nicholas Trudgian** is an accomplished aviation, landscape and railway artist who was heavily influenced by the late David Shepherd. His break was a commission to commemorate the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Royal Flying Corps / Royal Air Force, since when he has produced hundreds of paintings and sketches. Living in the Cotswolds he has a live-steam railway running around his garden.
