

## WARTIME IN THE COTSWOLDS - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### **PLEASE READ BEFORE SIGNING YOUR ENTRY FORM**

Entries must be presented in a complete and safe condition.

Entries must be insured against third party public liability. Please have your valid insurance certificate with you.

Entries and their parties must pay full regard to event officials/marshals' instructions and conduct themselves in a manner which will not inconvenience or endanger any persons at any time.

Trains will be in operation during the day and exhibitors, like visitors, must follow the railway's safety rules, in particular keeping only to marked public rights of way and track crossing places. In no circumstances should any exhibitor walk on the railway track.

No German uniforms permitted at this event.

Any accident should be reported to the event organiser (John Rogers 07757 280205)

### **VEHICLE EXHIBITS (REMEMBER - DON'T DRINK AND DRIVE)**

All vehicles must be insured against third party risks and be fully licensed and tested in accordance with the regulations applicable to that type of vehicle for road use. Please have proof of these items with you.

Vehicle owners must ensure that all drivers are fully competent and permitted by law (licensed and insured) to operate the vehicle.

No exhibit shall be left running unattended. All unattended vehicles shall be left securely braked and/or chocked.

A speed limit of 5 mph shall apply to all vehicles, including modern vehicles in all areas off the highway.

All entrants must pay full regard to the marshals' instructions and conduct themselves in a manner which does not inconvenience other road users or other persons at any time.

We recommend motor cyclists should wear approved crash helmets.

All armoured vehicle movements will have a walking attendant preceding the vehicle to clear the way. Please take care and be aware of children and pedestrians at all times.

No additional vehicle may be brought onto the site without prior permission.

### **CAMPING AND CARAVANS AT TODDINGTON**

Pitches are marked. Please reverse on with the marker on your offside edge.

There are standpipes on the field for drinking water (Blue Pipes)

Fires and barbeques may only be lit if a working fire extinguisher is to hand, and must not be left unattended. All ashes must be disposed of in the appropriate container marked ashes. To protect the grass please remove and reinstate turf if you think it could be damaged.

All rubbish to be disposed of in the appropriate bin, or taken home.

All chemical waste to be emptied in the chemical waste tank not in the portaloos or toilets. Rinse **ONLY** from the Bowser adjacent.

## **WEAPONS**

### **NO LIVE FIREARMS ALLOWED AT THIS EVENT**

All weapons being brought **MUST** be listed on the appropriate entry form.

Deactivated weapons **MUST** be accompanied by a valid deactivation certificate.

Blank fire arms must **NOT** have any ammunition with them.

Air soft weapons must **NOT** be accompanied by any gas canisters.

Bladed weapons must be sheathed at all times, unless being drawn forms part of a display.

All weapons must never be left unaccompanied.
